III. Summary Information

- Numeric Summary as a two-way table
- Histograms/Bar Graphs of each category
- Row or Column Relative Frequency Table

IV. Analysis

- State hypothesis
- Interpret results
- Refer to tables and/or graphs in your report when necessary.

V. Conclusions

- Summarize Results
- Discuss limitations of study. What are sources of error? What's wrong with your sample?
- Discuss possible further research
